



2023 The Glynn Academy Class of 1969 Memorial Scholarship

The Glynn Academy Class of 1969 Scholarship, will award a \$2,500 academic scholarship to a graduating Glynn Academy senior who has been accepted to attend a Georgia academic college or university. There will be no restriction regarding race, ethnicity, creed, or gender.

Requirements:

- Cumulative **HOPE** grade point average **between** a 2.70 and 2.99
- Provide family background and demonstrate financial need
- Applicant must be a good school citizen with: Excellent attendance, good academic standing with no failures and no disciplinary action or infractions
- Active involvement in extracurricular school and community activities.
- Complete and submit online application. (**register as an individual**)

The following information will be requested in the application:

- An official copy of your high school transcript including SAT/ACT test scores.
- Two letters of recommendation: One from an academic instructor and one from a community member who monitored community service.
- A photograph.

The scholarship to be awarded may be used for tuition, fees, room, and board. Payment will be made to the college on behalf of the recipient in halves prior to the start of each semester. Recipient must achieve at least a 3.0 average by the end of the 1st semester of college/university to receive the 2nd half of the scholarship. The student must submit a copy of their 1st semester grades to The Communities of Coastal Georgia Foundation info@coastalgeorgiafoundation.org, before they can receive the 2nd half of their award. If the student withdraws or otherwise fails to complete either semester, the money must be returned to the Foundation by the educational institution.
