2026 Award Year



A Post-Secondary Scholarship Program is offered to Graduating Glynn Academy Seniors with a HOPE GPA between 2.70 and 2.99.

SCHOLARSHIP OVERVIEW

The Glynn Academy Class of 1969 Scholarship will award \$5,000 in total (\$2,500 per semester for up to 2 semesters) to graduating Glynn Academy seniors who have been accepted to Georgia academic colleges or universities. The goal is to provide financial assistance during the students' first year of college to help them improve their GPA and qualify for the HOPE Scholarship.

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Cumulative **HOPE** grade point average **between 2.70 and 2.99**, at the time of High School Graduation.
- Demonstration as a good school citizen, including:
 - Excellent attendance
 - Good academic standing
 - No disciplinary action or infractions
- Active involvement in extracurricular school and community activities.
- A possible need for financial assistance
- Application includes:
 - An official copy of high school transcript, including SAT/ACT scores.
 - Two letters of recommendation: One from an academic instructor and one from a community member who monitored community service.
 - A short essay (*topic selections included in the application portal*)
 - A photograph of the applicant.

Post Award Details:

- The scholarship will be sent directly to the college before the start of each semester on behalf of the recipient. The scholarship award covers tuition, fees, and room and board expenses.
- Recipients must achieve at least a 3.0 average by the end of the first semester of college/university to receive the second half of the scholarship.
- The student must submit a copy of their first semester grades to The Communities of Coastal Georgia Foundation at info@coastalgeorgiafoundation.org before they can receive the second half of their award.
- In case of a student's withdrawal or inability to complete either semester, the educational institution is required to return the funds to the Foundation.

The application portal will open on Wednesday, February 4, 2026, and close on Wednesday, April 1, 2026.
