## **2026 William Bernard McCloud Community Impact Award Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)**

### **1. What is the purpose of this grant?**

This grant provides General Operating Support for 501(c)(3) organizations serving Camden, Glynn, and McIntosh counties.

### **2. What are the eligibility requirements?**

- Must be a 501(c)(3) organization.
- Must serve Camden, Glynn, or McIntosh counties.
- One application per organization (based on EIN).

### **3. What is the funding amount this year?**

The funding amount is \$15,000.

### **4. What are the key dates?**

- May 20: An hour online information session.
- June 1: Online application portal opens.
- June 18: Deadline to submit drafts to a professional grant writer for reviewing.
- July 1: Application portal closes.
- September: Interview session for selected applicants.
- Mid-October: Awards announced.
- October 30: Awards presentation.

### **5. What's new for 2026?**

- Free professional draft review.
- 2 bonus points for new applicants (new applicants refer to those who did not apply in 2023, 2024, or 2025).
- Application questions reorganized into smaller sections to better guide applicant responses.

### **6. What is the application process?**

Online application → Screening → Scoring → Interviews (top applicants) → Awards announced

### **7. Additional Notes**

- Local branches of national/state organizations may apply but must show funds are used only in the eligible counties.
- The Mission/Vision/Value question is required
- Upload supporting documents in "Attach any other reports or relevant information."
- Only 2025 recipients submit Interim Reports
- The 2,000-character limit includes space and punctuation. This does not equal 2,000 words; depending on word length and formatting, it typically equates to approximately 300–400 words.
